## **Garbage Removal, Recycling, Tree Maintenance and Protection Issues for Chatham Borough:**

**Curbside Garbage Pick-up** – Residential curbside garbage collection & disposal.

- Schedule – Contact Town Public Works for Zoning information.
  - Zone A – North side of Railroad, collection Monday & Thursday
  - Zone B – South side of Railroad, collection Tuesday & Friday
- Garbage must be put in specific Chatham Borough green trash bags that can be purchased at ShopRite, King’s Supermarket and Dreyer’s Lumber.
- The bulk pickup monthly collection will always be Thursday and Friday of the same week. Please check the monthly calendar for scheduled dates.
- Missed Solid Waste or Bulk Pickup? Call Suburban Disposal at 973-227-7020.

### **Curbside Recycling**

- Borough contracts for single-stream, all-in-one curbside recycling. No garbage bags.
- Recycling collection is every Friday.

### **Chatham Borough Recycling Depot**

- The Recycling Center at 90 Summit Avenue. Open Saturdays 9:00am-12:00pm.

### **Chatham Borough Mulch Area**

- The Mulch Area opens in the Spring and usually closes in December. Seasonal operating hours: Wednesdays 1:00 - 4:00pm, Saturdays 12:00 - 4:00pm.
- For complete Mulch site rules please refer to Borough Calendar.
- The following items can be disposed of at this site: grass, leaves, hedge clippings, and tree limbs up to 4" in diameter.
- Located on Duchamp Place. Do not enter via Duchamp Place or Elmwood Avenue between Weston Ave and Milton Ave while school is open. Please watch for children.
- \*Entrance to the site on Wednesday is via Center Ave to Milton Ave to Duchamp Place.
- Permits are required, which are issued only to residents.
- Permits will be permanently attached to your vehicle by the DPW at the Mulch Area during the above hours of operation.
- Leaf Collection – Leaves are vacuumed into trucks and then composted.
- Service Provider – Chatham Borough DPW 973-635-2417
- Schedule – See refer to Municipal Calendar <http://www.chathamborough.org>
- Materials Accepted:
  - Christmas Trees (Recycling) Collected in January by the Fire Department. For collection dates please refer to Municipal Calendar. Remove all decorations and no tree bags or stands.
  - Bagged Leaves (Recycling) are collected in accordance with the Municipal Calendar.

### **Curbside Bulk Waste Collection**

- Service – Large bulky items.
- Service Provider – Suburban Disposal 973-227-7020
- Curbside Schedule – Occurs monthly (Please refer to Municipal Calendar for schedule.)
- Materials Accepted: Household appliances (must have Freon removed), furniture, carpeting, luggage and other oversized items too big to fit in a green bag.

### **Roadside Tree Maintenance**

- The Borough maintains a public right of way, which may vary from street to street but averages usually ten (10) feet from the center point of the roadway. The Department of Public Works maintains all trees in the public right of way.
- Please call the department for more information 973-635-5242.

### **Tree Protection Ordinance**

- Chatham Borough has a Tree Protection Ordinance which extends to trees on private property. A permit is required to cut down any tree over 6 inches in diameter. The permits may be obtained from the Department of Community Services. There is a small fee related to the number of trees involved. The fee may be waived if the Construction Official or a Certified Tree Expert determines that the tree is dead.
- Application for Tree Removal Permit can be found on the Borough website under Boards & Commissions -> Shade Tree Commission.

## **Garbage Removal, Recycling, Tree Maintenance and Protection Issues for Chatham Township:**

**Curbside Garbage Pick-up** – Private residential garbage collection. Residents hire a private contractor for garbage collection and are free to choose any licensed refuse hauler. Many residents utilize Chatham Disposal who can be reached at 973-379-1268.

- No specific bags required.

### **Curbside Recycling**

- Township contracts for single-stream, all-in-one curbside recycling. Maximum weight of curbside recycling is 50 pounds; use multiple containers if needed.
- Service Provider – Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority 973-659-3490
- Recycling schedule at <http://www.chathamtownship-nj.gov/recycling>
- Recyclables must be curbside by the morning on collection days – every other Friday.
- Christmas tree recycling in January. Check township site for date each year.

### **Composting Stickers and Information**

- Available at the Municipal Building, Public Works or The Compost Area. Proof of residency is required. One permit per household. The residential permit is usable for a car or pick-up truck. Questions, call: 973-377-5114
- Acceptable materials – Grass Clippings, Leaves, Branches (Grass & Leaves must be separated). <http://www.chathamtownship-nj.gov/compost-area-guidelines>
- The Department of Public Works will deliver 2 ½ - 3 yards of mulch to your driveway for a fee of \$25.00. Payment is by check only and must be remitted with order.
- Mulch orders must be placed in person at the DPW, 405 Southern Blvd. Monday– Thursday, 8 am to 3 pm, in order to be scheduled for the next available delivery date. Deliveries are done on Friday mornings.
- You may also help yourself to mulch when the compost area is open.

### **Tree Protection Ordinance**

- To remove a tree on your property in Chatham Township, you must complete a “Tree Removal Permit Application”. ### **Additional Recycling: Large Rigid Plastics Recycling (Only at Recycling Center – NOT for Curbside Collection)**

- *What are large rigid plastics?* They are harder and thicker plastics than the plastic bottles you have been recycling. Large rigid plastics will be baled and sold to manufacturers who recycle them into new products. ### **Chatham Borough Train Station PARKING**

- Parking Information for the Borough of Chatham – 973-635-0674 x214
- Parking Permits for the Chatham Borough Railroad Station are available to Chatham *Borough* residents only, at a yearly cost of \$450.00.

- At the present time there is a waiting list. Application is located at [https://www.chathamborough.org/chatham/Member's%20Area/Member's%20Files/mboc\\_hniak/RR%20Station%20Program.pdf](https://www.chathamborough.org/chatham/Member's%20Area/Member's%20Files/mboc_hniak/RR%20Station%20Program.pdf)

- The hours of enforcement for the train station parking lot is 7 am and 4 pm, Monday through Friday, except on weekends and Holidays.

- Metered parking is available to the general public at \$5.50 per day. All metered spaces are numerically marked and exact change should be deposited in the box on the platform and the space number should be entered. A receipt will be issued as proof of payment. SMARTCARD - An easier way to pay for train station parking. Parking meters located at the South Side of the Train Station platform will accept the Smartcard Technology.

Purchasing Smartcard Options:

2. Purchase at train platform meters
3. Purchase at Borough of Chatham Municipal Building, Times - 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Monday - Friday

- Parkmobile is also an easier way to pay for train station parking.

1. Create an account at [www.parkmobile.com](http://www.parkmobile.com) and enter your credit card information and then download the mobile app
2. To park, enter your zone number and your space number

- If after 9:00 am, Monday through Friday, there are no daily paid parking spaces available, but there are a number of open permit spaces, you can obtain a daily parking permit to park in a vacant permit space. Individuals can purchase a daily parking permit for \$ 5.50 from the Utilities Clerk in room 205 of the Municipal Building located at 54 Fairmount Ave.

### **Alternative Daily Commuter Parking & Biking**

- Daily spaces are also available to the general public at train stations in Convent Station, Madison and Summit Train Station. A limited number of annual railroad parking permits are also available in Convent Station, Madison and Summit for the general public.

- Daily spaces are also available in Secaucus and Newark.

- Chatham Borough Train Station Lot offers free parking after 7 pm during weekdays and all day on weekends. Overnight parking is not permitted.

- Bike racks and lockers are available at the Chatham Borough Train Station

- Boxcar app sells private spaces for a daily fees and offers bus services to/from NYC.

## **Pet Licensing Requirements and Animal Control:**

### **Chatham Borough Pet Licensing Requirements**

- Residents with dogs or cats are required to license their pets. As required by the state, dogs and cats must be vaccinated for the license year before a license is issued, and a copy of the rabies vaccination certificate is required.

- The Borough offers a free rabies clinic each year in January, at the Firehouse.

- The license fee for a spayed/neutered dog or cat is \$18.00 per year. For non-spayed/neutered animals the fee is \$21.00. Renewals of existing licenses are due by January 31 of each year. A late fee of \$7.00 is charged for all renewals received after this date.

## Chatham Township Pet Licensing Requirements

- All dogs in the Township of Chatham must be registered by January 31<sup>st</sup> each year.
- Please note the following important licensing information needed:
  - In order to qualify for the spayed/neutered discount the owner must have proof on record at the Clerk's Office, submit it with the application, or sign a sworn statement with the veterinarian's name and address, date dog was spayed/neutered and the reason why no certificate from the veterinarian is available.
  - An updated rabies inoculation certificate must be attached to the application.
  - If mailing payment, be sure to include spay/neuter certificate, rabies certificate and check payable to Chatham Township.

To begin the registration process, you will need proof of residency (utility bill, license, mortgage, etc.) and the birth certificate for the new student. Children who will be five years old by October 1 of the year in which he/she applies for entrance are eligible to enter kindergarten in the fall. Please note that kindergarten in The Chathams is a half day program (a full day kindergarten option available by lottery). There are many enrichment and wrap around programs available. 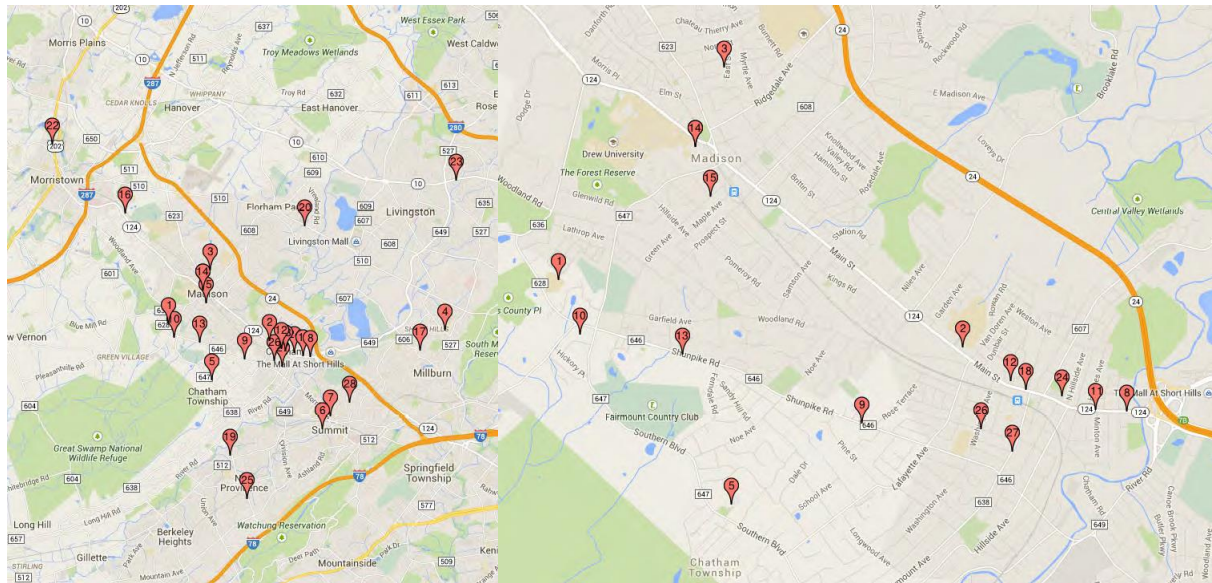

### **LYME DISEASE PREVENTION MESSAGE FROM THE GOVERNOR'S LYME DISEASE ADVISORY COUNCIL**

#### **Fact Sheet for Parents**

The State of New Jersey continues to have one of the highest rates of Lyme disease in the country. The disease is transmitted by the bite of an infected deer (black legged) tick. Common habitats for the deer tick are leaf litter in wooded areas, grassy areas along wooded edges and low bushes and shrubs. Deer ticks are not commonly found on athletic fields, cut lawns or agricultural fields. The majority of Lyme disease cases are caused by tick bites acquired around the home. Children may be at particular risk because of the amount of time they spend playing outdoors and the failure to recognize a tick bite.

**To help reduce this risk of tick exposure, remind your family of these “tick safety tips”:**

**-Before Going out:** Wear light-colored, tightly woven clothing to make it easier to spot ticks; tuck shirts into pants and pants into socks; wear closed shoes / sneakers rather than open sandals; use a tick repellent as directed. Products should contain DEET (for clothing OR skin) or Permethrin (for clothing ONLY).

- Remind children to ask an adult to apply the tick repellent and DO NOT apply to hands or face. Use products with less than 10% DEET and always follow manufacturers' directions carefully. Do not use repellents on children under 3 years of age.
- Pay particular attention to tops of shoes and lower portion of pant legs, as ticks are most likely to attach here.
- While Outside: Stay in the center of trails; avoid low bushes and leafy brush; periodically check clothing and skin for ticks and remove.
- Upon Return: Check clothing, skin, and hair for ticks (take special note of your child's navel, underarm, groin area and behind the ears). If a tick is found, remove it carefully with tweezers. If it was attached, note spot of attachment, mark calendar, and save tick in a jar for later identification. Should symptoms such as an expanding "bull's eye" rash, flu-like symptoms or painful joints develop, contact your physician.
- Don't Forget: It generally takes at least 36 hours after attachment for a deer tick to infect its host with the bacteria that causes Lyme disease. So remember: **Do tick checks DAILY!**

**Use These Steps for Proper Tick Removal:**

- GRASP tick as close to skin as possible, using tweezers.
- PULL gently with a steady, backward pressure—be patient!
- WASH area with soap, water, and topical antiseptic.
- \*REMEMBER: Incorrect removal of an attached tick can increase your risk for Lyme disease. Never burn, smother, or crush an attached tick.
